



Naming of roads in Fitzroy

Council is considering assigning names to two roads alongside Garryowen Park in Fitzroy.

This will enable new addresses to be assigned to units 1 to 6 at 25 Rose Street to assist with locating the properties by visitors, deliveries and emergency services. If you are the owner or occupier of one of these units and this project proceeds, your address will change. The addresses of units 7 to 12 at 25 Rose Street will be unaffected.





If you have a suggestion for a name for either (or both) of these roads, please let us know what you think they should be called, and why. If you think the roads should remain unnamed, let us know why.

In considering names for these rights-of-way, Council will be guided by its own policy and the State Government's Naming Rules for Places in Victoria.
