

Public Question Time

Most Council Meetings provide an opportunity to ask questions of the Yarra City Council about any matter that is not on the meeting agenda. This is known as 'Public Question Time', and takes place near the beginning of the meeting. If you have a question about a Council matter, the Mayor will answer your question or refer it to one of the Council officers present.

To ask a question, you are requested to complete this form and submit it to us by 12 noon on the day of the meeting. This will give us enough time to make any necessary enquiries to provide you with an answer at the meeting.

Each person may ask a maximum of 2 questions. If you have 2 questions, you may submit 2 forms.
