Response to Council Motion: Public Art & Civic Signage Opportunities

Considerations

- Murals and projections can be images and/or text.
- Murals generally have a life span 5-10 years.
- Sculptures generally have a life span of 25 years plus.
- Projections more likely to be temporary/short term installations.
- Cost estimates for painting on road and footpaths is \$40-50 m2 plus traffic management.
- Cost estimate for projection \$2-5k per site.
- Cost estimate for murals \$5k+ (dependent on artist fees, traffic management and equipment hires).
- Cost estimate for sculptures \$30k+
