Bond Determination and Application Fee

Council may require an Asset Protection Bond where it is identified Council assets may be damaged during the building works. The Bond is refundable.

Information 1

It is important for council to understand what heavy equipment will be used (cranes, excavators etc) as the delivery and operation of this equipment may have significant impact on council assets.

Information 2

Road/Footpath Road Occupation Permit is required if you:

- Need to place hoardings, scaffolding, gantries, building materials, ladders, site sheds, concrete pumps, elevated work platforms, mobile scaffolding, etc or
- Require a work area for plant and equipment
- Need to place cranes on Council land including encroachment by the jib or stabilising legs and/or requires a work area for other hoisting devices and supporting vehicles.
- Require a works-zone for construction vehicle parking

Information 3

Road/Footpath Opening and Service Connections

If you need to carry out works in the road, including working on or connecting new services such as water, underground power supply or stormwater, you will need a permit from Council. This applies to access to any Council managed land.

You may need other approvals before even applying for the Road/Footpath Opening consent, depending on the purpose of the road opening.

Information 4

Bond determination is based on a dilapidation inspection that occurs prior to any works being carried out. Bond calculation is determined by assessing the likelihood of a damaging event occurring and the potential significance of that damage.

Bluestone laneways, delivery methods, proximity of works to the property boundary are just some key influencers of bond determination.

A **minimum** of a \$5000 bond or bank guarantee will be required when a bond is requested for your proposed works.

The Bond amount can be supplied by two methods:

1. Direct Payment to Council by Cash, Cheque, Credit Card
2. Bank Guarantee. You can approach your bank to draw up a BG which can then be supplied to Council. (all bank guarantees must not have an end date)

Information 5

A Temporary Vehicle Crossing Permit is needed when access to a property is needed during a construction project and there is no existing vehicular access to the property from the roadway.
