Re: P26027 - Nylex Sign, 2 Gough Street, Cremorne (H2049)

I write with regard to the abovementioned heritage place and a heritage permit issued on 29 March 2017.

Condition 1 of this permit is as follows:

This permit shall expire if the permitted works have not commenced within three (3) years of the issue of this permit, or are not completed within seven (7) years of the date of issue of this permit unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Executive Director, Heritage Victoria.

It is respectfully requested that condition 1 be amended to increase the validity of the permit by an additional two years, i.e. that works may commence within five (5) years from the date of issue. Please note that works are underway on the Richmond Maltings (H2050) site as associated with permit number P22508, which are related to the approved works to the Nylex sign by permit P26027.

It is also respectfully requested that the associated permit amendment fee is waived in accordance with s. 26(d), Heritage Regulations 2017 as the works are the same or primarily the same as those previously approved. The relevant form is enclosed with this correspondence.
