Declarations

Date	Declaration
16/3/2021 Council meeting	Cr Landes declared a general conflict of interest in relation to Item 13.1 - Mental Health Services in Yarra. He declared that he believes there may be a perceived conflict of interest.
20/4/2021 Council meeting	Cr Landes declared a general conflict of interest in relation to Item 8.3 - Bridge Road and Victoria Street - Permanent Built Form Provisions. He declared that he has property interests in Bridge Road in the area affected by the proposed provisions.
