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Question Without Notice

Question from Councillor Stephen Jolly

In the last 48 hours, some residents have received a letter from the Linking Melbourne Authority (LMA) informing them that there will be eminent drilling but the letter does not specify the location of the bore test sites. Are officers aware of this letter and can they provide details of the bore test sites to the residents of the City of Yarra?

Response

The Mayor noted that there had been officer contact with the Linking Melbourne Authority and requested the Acting Chief Executive Officer to respond.

The Acting Chief Executive Officer responded that:

- (a) Council was required by the Minister for Roads to issue a permit for consent for 14 new locations for bore hole drilling;*
- (b) consent was issued on the 27 December 2013;*
- (c) as part of the permit conditions, before the works commence at each bore site, the LMA will ensure Council is notified; and*
- (d) Council is yet to receive any formal notification of any of the 14 bore sites.*

RECOMMENDATION

This means: the area defined in (c) (iii) above is a NO ALCOHOL AREA and in the remaining area:

“A person may in a public place in a prescribed area during day-time hours (i.e. 9.00 am to 8.59 pm):

- (a) *consume liquor responsibly; or*
 - (b) *be in possession of liquor in an open container; provided it is in such manner as not to disturb or be likely to disturb the amenity or enjoyment of the public place or of land in the vicinity of the public place”;*
- (d) Council pursuant to **Clause 14** of the “Consumption of Liquor in Public Places” Local Law No. 8 - require the above determination to be published in a newspaper circulating generally in the municipal district;

Attachment 2 - Edinburgh Gardens Notice Board Map

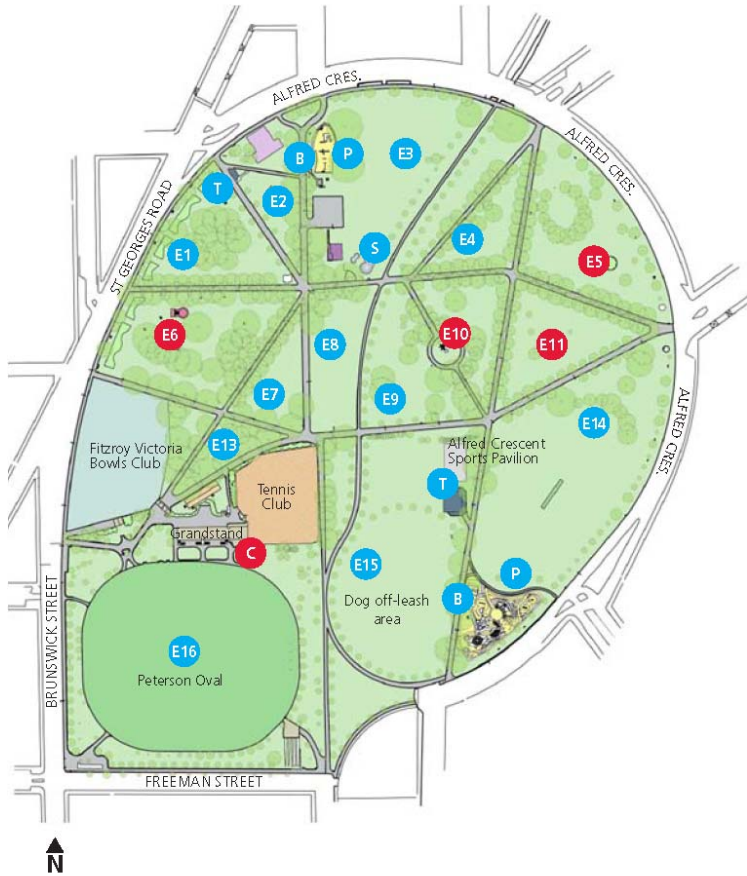


PARK RESERVATIONS
