7.1 Michelle Swageman – Graffiti Trials

Question:

As a participant in the graffiti trials we have identified an opportunity for improvement where the community can be supported in addressing graffiti. As it currently stands, the community must take it upon themselves to contact asset owners to report graffiti. This is an opportunity for Council to implement a one-stop graffiti reporting initiative. Would Council investigate such a suggestion?

Response:

The Mayor invited the Project Officer, Waste Management and Cleansing to respond. He informed the questioner that Council does currently pass on reports of graffiti to asset owners when they are reported to us, but the responsiveness of those organisation has been mixed. Council intends to trial a central reporting system.
