More and more people are creating all-electric homes powered by renewable energy.

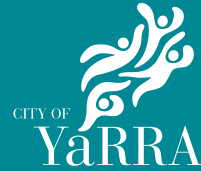
Modern electric appliances are efficient, safe and cost-effective. With solar or a GreenPower electricity plan you can power your all-electric home with 100% renewable energy.

Here's how to get started:

- Install solar to generate your own electricity and save on your bills
- Switch your heating, hot water, and cooking to electric when they need replacing.

Heating

- Heating can be up to 40% of your winter energy bill.
- Reverse cycle air conditioning can be the cheapest way to heat and cool your home - and it doesn't have the health risks of gas.
- You may be eligible for a Victorian Government rebate of up to \$1,000 to switch to an efficient electric heater.

Hot water

- A modern heat pump hot water system uses a fraction of the electricity of other electric hot water systems.
- You may be eligible for a Victorian Government rebate of up to \$1,000 to switch to a heat pump hot water system.

Cooking

- Induction cooking heats food quickly and evenly, while the surfaces around the pan stay cool and safe.
- You can save hundreds each year on connection fees by switching that last appliance to electric and disconnecting your gas supply.

Next steps to electrifying everything:

- Add battery storage to use your solar electricity in the evening
- Switch to an electric car if you need a vehicle and recharge with renewable energy at home. Better still, consider an electric bike or scooter!
