When dropping off or picking up your kids, please remember to use designated parking areas and avoid 'no stopping' zones. Model safe behaviour by following all traffic rules and being patient, particularly during busy times. Children can be impulsive, so it's vital we create safe environments by setting good examples. Always supervise your children near traffic and let them out on the kerb side. If you see any unsafe situations, please report them to the council, your vigilance is crucial.
